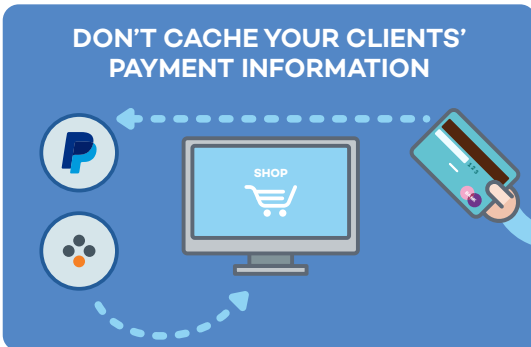


Tips on How to Shield Your Online Store for the Holidays

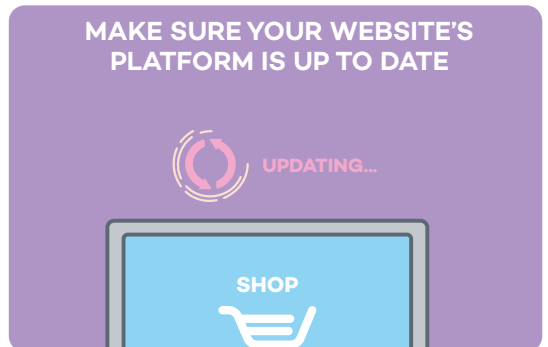


DON'T CACHE YOUR CLIENTS' PAYMENT INFORMATION



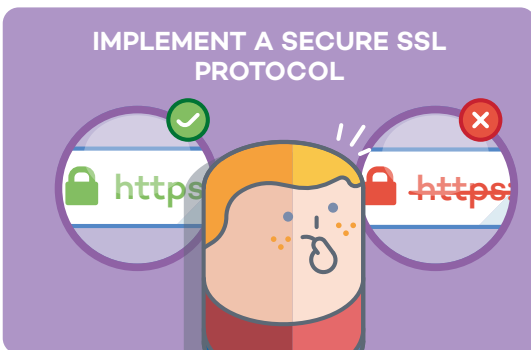
Ensure that your clients' credit card information is not logged.

MAKE SURE YOUR WEBSITE'S PLATFORM IS UP TO DATE



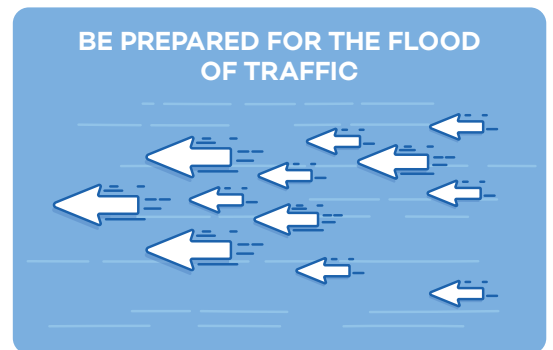
Search the Internet for common vulnerabilities of these tools and look for a way to remedy them.
