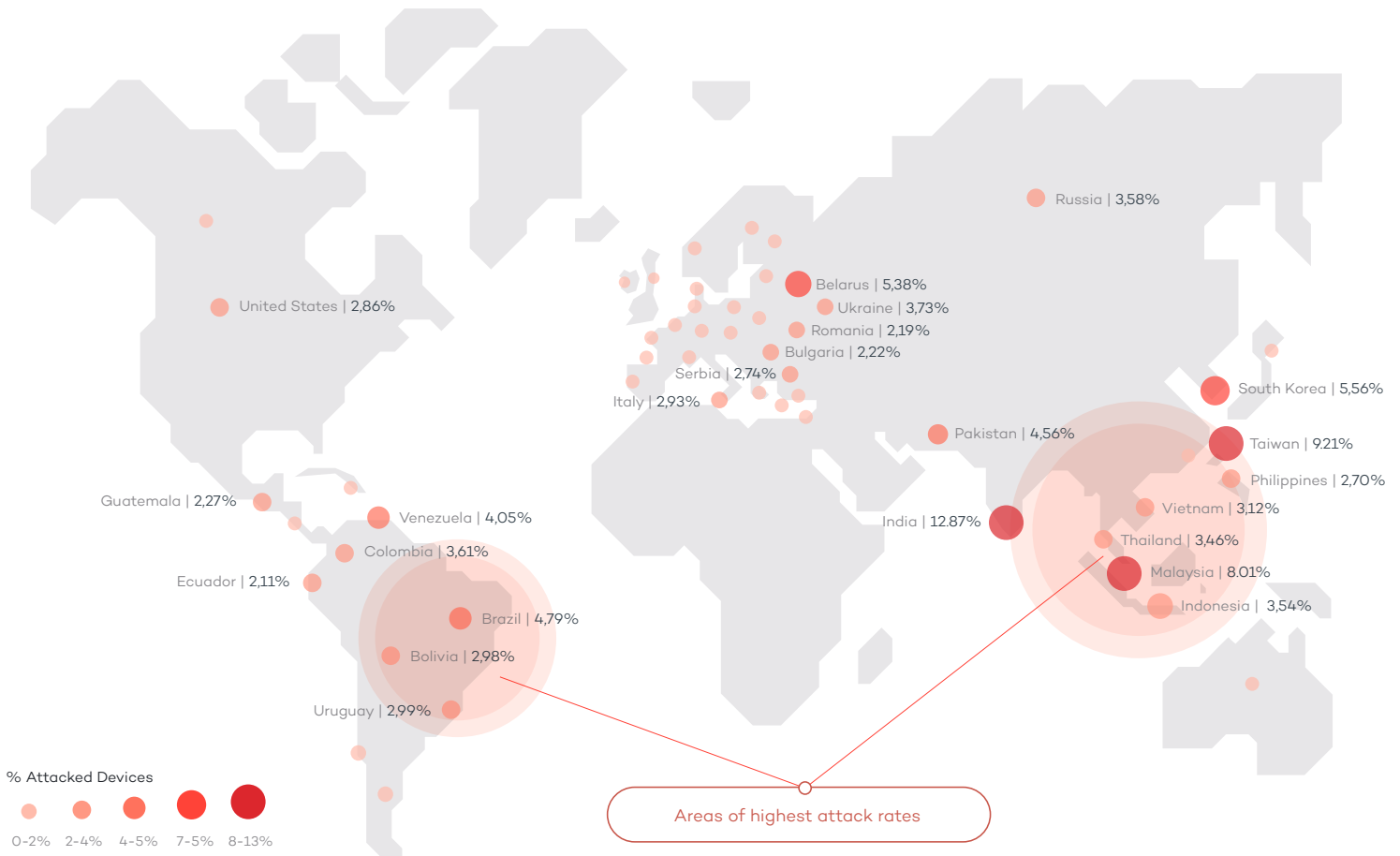


Analysis of Attacks

At Panda Security, we've always been passionate about client protection, so a few years ago our laboratory created a layer of protection that we decided to add to all our solutions. This layer only comes into play when all other layers of protection fail. That way, we know that everything we stop there is a completely new attack.

In terms of the geographical distribution of these attacks, we have calculated the percentage of machines attacked in each country. The greater the percentage, the greater the probability of being attacked by new threats when using computers in those countries.

ATTACKS FROM UNKNOWN THREATS

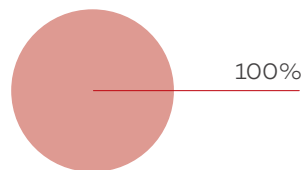
The figure shows the percentage of all devices protected by a Panda Security solution which suffered attacks from unknown threats.

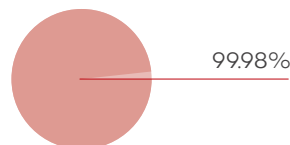


AV - COMPARATIVES TESTS Q1 2017

TRADITIONAL ANTIVIRUS VS. ADAPTIVE DEFENSE

Since **Adaptive Defense adds higher security levels**, the percentage of attacks that were blocked after skipping the rest of protection layers is much lower in Adaptive Defense than in traditional protection systems.
